



The **Branch Adult Training Coordinator VISTA** will support the development and implementation of a job skills and education program at the Mountain View Library, integrating with and supporting the goals of its current partners — the United Way of Anchorage, the Anchorage community Land Trust and the Alaska Department of Labor and Workforce Development.

This library is staffed by a Branch Manager, Youth Services Librarian and three full-time support staff. The successful VISTA will build on a burgeoning project to develop the Mountain View Library into an adult learning center with an emphasis on job skills and readiness classes as well as ESL classes.

The VISTA will recruit skilled volunteers from community organizations and the general public to implement and maintain educational and enrichment goals and build a greater sense of community.

Benefits include: Monthly living allowance (\$1,222), relocation costs (\$0.34 per mile up to \$1,000) and settling in allowance (\$550), health benefits, child care assistance, training, and an Education Award (\$5,775) or cash stipend (\$1,500).
