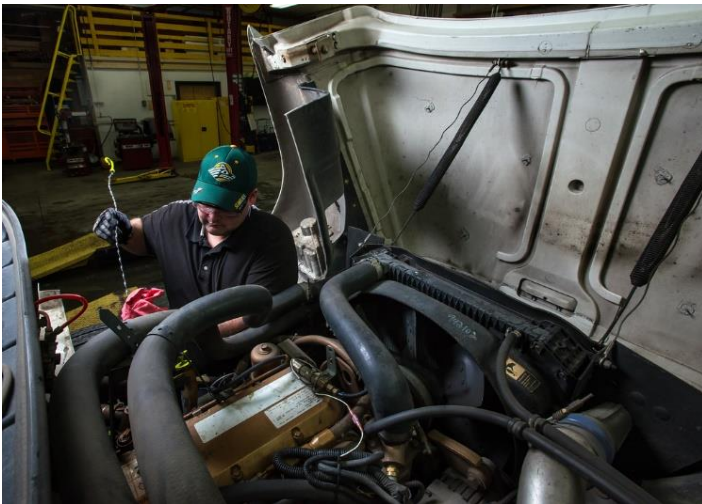


Apprenticeship Building Alaska's Future

Registered apprenticeships benefit Alaska's employers by training workers to industry specifications, increasing workforce productivity, enhancing retention and developing future leadership.



Diesel and Automotive Technician Apprenticeship programs

UAA is opening its Diesel and Automotive Apprenticeship programs for recruitment beginning Nov. 13, 2019.

Apprentices will receive technical instruction as well as college credits from our Automotive Diesel and Transportation department, while gaining work experience on the job.

How to apply

Applications for apprenticeship will be accepted on an open enrollment basis throughout the year at UAA. Applications must be filled out completely, including all requested documentation. **Only completed applications with all relevant documentation attached will be considered for an interview.**

A limited number of positions will be available. Applicants will be placed on a list based on the score received during their interview. As jobs become available applicants will interview with employers in order of their position on the list, those hired will enter into the apprenticeship program.
