## Poll Workers in Anchorage and Mat-Su

### \$15 per hour (temporary)

- Your community needs YOU! Alaska must recruit and train hundreds of poll workers in communities across the state?
- Do you like helping people and would like to get paid to serve your community?

#### REQUIREMENTS:

- Must be a registered voter in Alaska.
- Be willing to work an approximate 16-hour day or more on Election Day, or share a position and work a split shift, and attend a four- to five-hour paid training session.
- Must be willing to remain non-partisan on Election Day and NOT express any political opinions while on the job.
- Cannot have a familial relationship with a candidate on the ballot.

#### It's as easy as 1-2-3:

1. First, you'll attend a paid training session to learn how to be a poll worker. Then, you're ready to go to work.
2. On Election Day, you'll help set up the polling place before your neighbors arrive to vote.
3. Finally, you'll check voters in at the polling place and issue ballots. Once the day is done, you and your fellow poll workers will close the polling place.
