The Alaska Ironworker Registered Apprenticeship is a 4-year, 6000-hour program that provides training in all aspects of the ironworking trade including welding and structural and reinforcing ironworking.

An Apprentice Ironworker is a person who is in training to become a Journey-level Ironworker upon completion of the program. The program includes 634 hours of direct instruction at the training center, and the additional hours "earning while you learn" working in the field. Apprentice Ironworkers also earn additional fringe benefits including health and retirement benefits.
