### **Minimum requirements:**

- Assists with pre-season and day-to-day deck operations of the vessel. Responsible for operating the deck in accordance with Trident policy.
- Assists in overseeing and establishing the performance and operation standards for all vessel deck equipment.
- Assists in directing and overseeing launching, retrieval, operation and maintenance of a skiff.
- Must be able to safely operate or work with cranes, hooks, anchor winches, slings, and other lifting devices.
- Must be able to direct and assist in loading and stowing of vessel supplies.
- Must be able to safely and compently work in extreme weather and sea conditions as needed.
- Must be able to, when trained, stand underway and anchor watches.
- Must be able to follow to specific directions in the case of an emergency. Can include launching a raft, donning an Immersion suit or life perserver, assist in a response to fire or flooding.
- Maintains a working knowledge of safety policies and regulations to ensure duties of self and others are performed in a safe manner.
